You have received a lot of information about Catholic Schools Week activities. If you have any questions, please ask for clarification on anything. I will send out Remind notices throughout the week and update facebook as well. We hope to see you and some potential new students this Sunday at the Open House.

Report cards will be sent home with your child on Friday, January 26, 2016. Please send back the envelope but keep the report card. Kindergarten, first grade and small groups of students will also have MAP scores sent home with report cards. MAP in winter is one way to check your child's progress, however, if a student has a dip in their score, that can help the teacher to adjust their instruction to make sure the student learns what they need to before the end of the year. St. Clare teachers will have ongoing inservice on the use of data to drive their instruction. We have MAP, running records for reading, classroom assessments and report cards to gauge where the students are in their learning.

With the generosity of matching funds from Catholic Financial, Wrightstown and Greenleaf, our proceeds from Breakfast with St. Nick was \$5383! Last year's event was \$4,000. This event continues to grow each year and is a wonderful way for the community, church and school families to come together to enjoy the morning.
