Even after Jesus gives the beloved disciple a hint as to who it would be by sharing a piece of bread with Judas and sending him on his way, they still do not understand. The disciples believe that Jesus was sending him on an errand to buy supplies for the feast, or perhaps to bring money to the poor (John 13:29).*
