Good News!! Any current St. Clare families are now able to apply for the WPCP! Last week, School Choice Wisconsin, a state-wide organization that serves all schools participating in the Choice program in Wisconsin, learned that the Wisconsin Legislature would allow all current students in new schools to the program to receive a Voucher as long as the new school had an existing school as a sponsor. **We are pleased to announce that the St. Francis Xavier System has agreed to sponsor our school. This means that if your child is in grades 2 – 8 for the 2019-2020 school year, and you meet the financial and residential requirements, you can receive a Voucher to pay for your tuition. Previously, the program was only open to current students in grades, 4K, kindergarten and grade 1.** Student applications must be completed by the parents no later than April 19, 2019. Since we do not have school April 18 & 19, please apply by April 15, time is of the essence! See the flyer in today's folder with the details.
