"Today we honor St. Joseph, spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is interesting to note that St. Joseph's fatherhood and specific role in the plan of salvation would not have been possible apart from his marriage to Mary. St. John Paul II referred to St. Joseph as "the guardian and cooperator in the providential mystery of God (no 14)." He explained that, together with Mary, Joseph was the first guardian of Christ: "St. Joseph was called by God to serve the person and mission of Jesus directly through the exercise of his fatherhood (no 8).""
